

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 21 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

from which remains of the bearing trees marked by Price, in 1945,

A sawed and burned fir stump, 50 ins. diam., bears N. $10\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 101 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.

A stump hole, bears S. $33\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 91 lks. dist.

A sawed and burned fir stump, 48 ins. diam., bears S. $15^{\circ}45'$ W., 53 lks. dist., bearing a rusted metal tag.

A fir snag, 40 ins. diam., bears N. $30\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 76 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.

The remains of the original bearing trees are gone.

Land, mountainous. Soil, burned shale and rocky clay. Timber and undergrowth destroyed by fire.

From the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23.

N. $3^{\circ}34'$ W., bet. secs. 14 and 15.

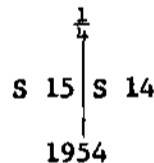
Descend 110 ft. along W. slope, changing to NW. slope, through burned area.

8.75 Intermittent branch, 2 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 770 ft. over SE. slope.

32.50 Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 135 ft. over NW. slope.

36.94 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 14 and 15, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

An iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., set 28 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S. 20° E., 45 lks. dist., with brass cap marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S14 RM 1954 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

An iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., set 28 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears N. 20° W., 45 lks. dist., with brass cap marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S15 RM 1954 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

Descend 160 ft. over broken NW. slope.

48.05 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 200 ft. over NW. slope.

48.85 Intermittent branch, 2 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 125 ft. over SW. slope.

53.00 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 80 ft. over NW. slope.

56.10 Branch, 1 lk. wide, flowing on bedrock bottom, 10 lks. wide, course S. 70° W.; asc. 220 ft. over SW. slope.

64.80 Ridge, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.; leave total burn area, edge bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.; desc. 270 ft. over NE. slope, changing to N. slope, through heavy timber and burned undergrowth.
