Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 30 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 25 ins. diam., bears S. $36\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 60 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT.

Ascend 143 ft. over NE. slope.

45.50 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 24 ft. over NW. slope.

49.83 Ravine, drains NE.; asc. 290 ft. over SE. slope, changing to E. slope.

59.02 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 10 ft. over general NE. slope.

59.37 Point for the W $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 30 and 31.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Descend 10 ft. over general NE. slope.

61.40 Ravine, drains NE.; asc. 404 ft. over E. slope, changing to NE. slope.

79.84 The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, on W. bdy. of Tp.

Land, mountainous. Soil, clay loam and rocky. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, dogwood, yew and alder; undergrowth, vine maple, fern, hazel, arrowwood, salal and blackberry.

Subdivision of Sec. 31, T. 24 S., R. 3 W.

Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31 only, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.

N. $0^\circ 31'$ E., along the N. and S. center line of sec. 31.

Descend 139 ft. over NE. slope, through logged area, with scattering timber, reproduction and undergrowth.

4.17 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW.; asc. 27 ft. along W. slope.

5.32 Gravel surfaced access road, bears NW. and SE.
