Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the S. Bdy., T. 24 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

from which the only remaining original bearing trees

A dead fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 5° E., 56 lks. dist., with scribe mark B and other illegible scribe marks visible on partially opened blaze. (Record distance, 50 lks.)

A cedar, 45 ins. diam., bears S. 28° W., 25 lks. dist., with scribe marks S 3 B T visible on opened blaze.

and locally established bearing trees

A white fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 37½° E., 29 lks. dist., mkd. T24S R8W S35 RE 2741.

A white fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 69½° E., 55 lks. dist., mkd. T24S R8W S35 RE 2741.

A white fir, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 81½° E., 40 lks. dist., mkd. S2 CS BT.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 35° W., 36 lks. dist., with scribe marks R8W S34 BT visible on partially healed blaze.

N. 88°42' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 34, marking and blazing the true line.

Descend 73 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth, along S. edge of logged and burned area.

9.43 Bottom of descent, slopes S.; ascend 5 ft. over SE. slope.

11.43 Top of ascent, slopes S.; descend 23 ft. over SW. slope.

16.42 Bottom of descent, slopes SE.; ascend 24 ft. over SE. slope.

20.30 Top of ascent, slopes S.; descend 40 ft. over SW. slope.

25.26 Bottom of descent, slopes S.; ascend 130 ft. over SE. slope.

33.03 Spur, slopes SE.; descend 31 ft. over SW. slope.

35.57 Ravine, drains S.; ascend 104 ft. over SE. slope.

39.245 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 34 only, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.

A madrone, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 5° W., 57 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S34 BT.

Ascend 100 ft. over SE. slope.

41.53 Ridge, bears N. 10° E. and S. 20° W.; descend 348 ft. over NW. slope

62.64 Ravine, drains N.; ascend 231 ft. over NE. slope.

67.90 Spur, slopes N. 10° E.; descend 29 ft. over NW. slope.
