Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the S. Bdy., T. 24 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A white fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.  $31\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  E., 25 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T25S R8W CC S4 CS BT.

A white fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S.  $3\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  W., 61 lks. dist.,  
mkd. T25S R8W CC S4 CS BT.

Land, rolling hills. Soil, rocky clay loam. Timber, fir, cedar,  
maple and hemlock; undergrowth, hazel, huckleberry, fir reproduc-  
tion and salal.

T. 24 S., R. 8 W.

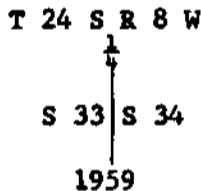
(Restoring the 1894 survey by Henry L. Chandler)

From the cor. of secs. 33 and 34 only, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.  
N.  $1^\circ 32'$  W., bet. secs. 33 and 34, marking and blazing the true  
line.

Descend 363 ft. over NW. slope, along W. edge of logged area,  
through dense undergrowth.

- 15.68 Foot of descent, slopes W.; ascend 17 ft. along W. slope.
- 22.27 Top of ascent, slopes W.; descend 6 ft. along W. slope.
- 26.41 Foot of descent, slopes W.; ascend 43 ft. over SW. slope.
- 32.35 Spur, slopes N.  $10^\circ$  E.; descend 107 ft. over NW. slope.
- 39.725 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, at proportionate  
distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 26 ins. in the  
ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which

A hemlock, 13 ins. diam., bears N.  $88\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  E., 30 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S34 BT.

A white fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S.  $49^\circ$  W., 29 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S33 BT.

Descend 512 ft. over NW. slope.

- 50.93 Case Knife Creek, 6 lks. wide, course E.; ascend 233 ft. over SE.  
slope.
- 79.45 The cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33, and 34, perpetuated and recorded by  
the County Surveyor, in 1958, monumented with an iron post,  $1\frac{1}{2}$   
ins. diam., firmly set, 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.
