Dependent Resurvey of the 5th Stan. Par. S., N. Bdy. T. 23 S., R. 6 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears S. $26\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ E., 109 lks. dist.,
mkd. T23S R6W S1 SC BT.

A fir, 54 ins. diam., bears S. 67° W., 203 lks. dist.,
mkd. T23S R6W S2 SC BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy and rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar. Undergrowth, salal, poison oak, vine maple, laurel, chinquapin, bracken fern, huckleberry, and Oregon grape.

N. $89^\circ 30'$ W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 2.

Ascend 20 ft. over gradual SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

8.20 Point for the closing cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 22 S., R. 6 W., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears S. 60° W., 87 lks. dist.,
mkd. XBT.

Ascend 26 ft. over SE. slope.

18.00 Ridge, bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.; desc. 310 ft. over NW. slope.

27.00 Ravine, course N. 20° W.; asc. 93 ft. over NE. slope.

30.65 Small spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 165 ft. over NW. slope.

40.24 Point for the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 2, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
