Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S. 73° W.; asc. 110 ft. over SW. slope.

The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, determined at record bearing and distance from the original bearing trees:

A maple stub, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 10° E., 54 lks. dist., mkd. with partial scribe marks.

A fir, 77 ins. diam., bears S. 75° E., 38 lks. dist., mkd. S7 T23S R6W BT.

A fir, dead and burned, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 60° W., 26 lks. dist., mkd. with partial scribe marks on open blaze.

A stump hole, bears N. 80° W., 57 lks. dist.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A cedar, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 3° E., 54 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R6W S7 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 60° W., 36 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R7W S12 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 60° W., 64 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R7W S1 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar. Undergrowth, salal, vine maple, alder, salmonberry, poison oak, and maple.

N. 0°33' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Ascend 27 ft. over SW. slope.

Fire break, 14 lks. wide, bears N. 77° E. and S. 77° W.; asc. 400 ft. over S. slope.

Fire break, 14 lks. wide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; spur, slopes S. 30° E.; asc. 24 ft. over NE. slope.

Head of swale, drains E.; asc. 45 ft. over SE. slope.

Spur, slopes E.; desc. 44 ft. over NE. slope.

23.26

Wet ravine, drains N. 85° E.; asc. 112 ft. over SE. slope.

27.50

Trail, in fire break, 14 lks. wide, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.; desc. 73 ft. over NE. slope, changing to N. slope.

Spur, slopes N. 45° E.; desc. 210 ft. over broken NE. slope.
