Dependent Resurvey of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 23 S., R. 6 W.

CHAINS

N. 0°30' E., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 68 ft. over SE. slope.

3.00 Spur, slopes N. 45° E.; desc. 294 ft. over NW. slope.

6.90 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course N. 75° E.; asc. 179 ft. over SE. slope.

15.00 Spur, slopes N. 70° E.; desc. 276 ft. over N. slope.

20.75 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course E.; asc. 301 ft. over SE. slope.

30.00 Spur, slopes S. 70° E.; desc. 89 ft. over NE. slope.

32.10 Ravine, drains E.; asc. 101 ft. over SE. slope.

36.50 Road, 30 lks. wide, bears E. curving NE., and W. curving NW.

39.02 Point for the cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, and 14, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 20° E., 227 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R6W S13 BT.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 9¼° W., 349 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R6W S14 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 32½° W., 300 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R6W S11 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, and cedar. Undergrowth, salal, madrone, manzanita, poison oak, and vine maple.

From the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18, on the E. bdy. of the Tp. S. 83°18' W., bet. secs. 12 and 13.

Ascend 284 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

8.40 Spur, slopes N. 30° W.; desc. 616 ft. over W. slope.

28.44 Road, bears NW. and SE.

38.06 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 15° W.; asc. 60 ft. over NE. slope.

39.98 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 12 and 13, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
