

Dependent Resurvey of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 23 S., R. 6 W.

CHAINS

Ascend 69 ft. over NE. slope.

50.83 Ridge, bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E.; desc. 61 ft. over SW. slope.

53.02 Road, unimproved, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.; desc. 398 ft. over W. slope.

78.55 Road, unimproved, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 25° E. and S. 25° W.; desc. 68 ft. over W. slope.

83.04 Road, unimproved, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.; desc. 78 ft. over NW. slope.

87.16 Road, unimproved, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.; desc. 153 ft. over NW. slope.

93.57 The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.

Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy loam. Timber, fir, maple, and cedar. Undergrowth, vine maple, poison oak, and salal.

From the cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31, and 32.

N. 10°48' W., bet. secs. 29 and 30.

Ascend 113 ft. along W. slope.

23.97 Small ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 63 ft. over N. slope.

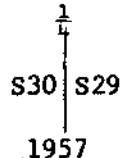
30.88 Gully, drains W.; asc. 21 ft. over S. slope.

32.34 Head of ravine, drains W.; desc. 145 ft. over N. slope.

40.03 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 30, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 64 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S29 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 20 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S30 BT.

Descend 105 ft. over N. slope.

42.64 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 291 ft. over S. slope.

56.40 Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 143 ft. over NW. slope.

75.76 Creek, 7 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 241 ft. over SE. slope.

80.06 Point for the cor. of secs. 19, 20, 29, and 30, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
