A sugar pine, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 16° E., 41 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A down fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 69° E., 54 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

add one new bearing tree

A hemlock, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 7½° W., 66 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S22 BT.

S. 89°57' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 4 ft. along S. slope.

- 0.36 Creek, 6 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 125 ft. along S. slope.
- 5.30 Dirt access road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.
- 13.00 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 72 ft. along S. slope.
- 22.20 Enter swamp, edge bears NE. and SW.; drains S.
- 24.20 Leave swamp, enter timber, edge bears N. and S.; asc. 38 ft. along S. slope.
- 32.15 Top of ascent, slopes S.; desc. 39 ft. along S. slope.
- 36.22 Dirt access road, 20 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.
- 39.42 The cor. of secs. 15 and 22 only, which is also cor. No. 8 of Tract 37, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., protruding 8 ins. above ground, firmly set in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, set by Mensch in 1918, with brass cap mkd.

A sugar pine, 32 ins. diam., bears N. 60° E., 31 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A madrone, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 44° E., 16 lks. dist., with scribe marks 2 22 B visible on a partially healed blaze.

A fir snag, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 76° W., 12 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 74° W., 6 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 20½° W., 31 lks. dist., mkd. T26S R2W S21 BT.
