A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 56° W., 34 lks. dist.,
mkd. E 1/16 S3 BT.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 53 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist.,
mkd. E 1/16 S10 BT.

Ascend 24 ft. along N. slope.

20.00 Spur, slopes N. 15° W.; desc. 578 ft. over NW. slope.

38.85 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 10, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the
ground, with brass cap mkd.

mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S3 BT.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 59 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E., 42 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S10 BT.

Descend 427 ft. over NW. slope.

55.75 Creek, 8 lks. wide, course S. 20° W.; asc. 316 ft. over SE. slope, changing to E. slope.

72.15 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 123 ft. over W. slope.

77.70 The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10.

Land, mountainous. Soil, loam and rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, sugar pine, madrone, chinquapin, maple, alder, dogwood and yew; undergrowth, salal, vine maple, Oregon grape, rhododendron, huckleberry and hazel.

N. 0°53' E., bet. secs. 3 and 4.

Ascend 26 ft. over broken SW. slope, through heavy timber and
dense undergrowth.

2.50 Spur, slopes W.; also foot trail, bears E. and W.; desc. 26 ft. over NW. slope.

5.27 Foot of descent, slopes W.; asc. 63 ft. over SW. slope.

7.03 Leave timber, enter meadow, edge bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.

8.45 Leave meadow, enter timber, edge bears N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.

14.18 Top of ascent, slopes W.; desc. 21 ft. over NW. slope.

16.95 Ravine, drains W.; asc. 12 ft. along W. slope.
