Leave logged area, enter timber, edge bears NW. and SE.

Creek, 5 lks. wide, course N.; asc. 149 ft. over NE. slope.

Spur, slopes N.; desc. 470 ft. over broken NW. slope.

From this point the closing cor. of secs. 19 and 20, bears North, $4\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., monumented by Mensch in 1918, with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., protruding 8 ins. above ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 75° W., 54 lks. dist., mkd. T26S R2W S18 BT.

Land, mountainous. Soil, clay and rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, pine, cedar and maple; undergrowth, hazel, vine maple, ocean spray, poison oak, huckleberry, rhododendron and salal.
