Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 26 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS
66.37 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 72 ft. over SE. slope.

75.48 Top of ascent, slopes S.; desc. 18 ft. over SW. slope.

78.48 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay with rock outcroppings. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, chinquapin, madrone, maple, alder, dogwood and yew; undergrowth, salal, Oregon grape, huckleberry, vine maple, rhododendron, hazel and poison oak.

N. 82°47' W., bet. secs. 6 and 7.

Descend 54 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

2.00 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 147 ft. over NE. slope.

11.02 Spur ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 438 ft. over SW. slope.

31.15 Foot of descent, slopes SW.; asc. 38 ft. over SE. slope.

33.50 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 40 ft. over SW. slope.

40.05 Foot of descent, slopes S.; continue over level ground.

42.035 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 25 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

75.10 Spur ridge, bears N. and S.; desc. 45 ft. over SW. slope.

79.02 Foot of descent, slopes S.; asc. 25 ft. over SE. slope.

81.00 Top of ascent, slopes S.; desc. 21 ft. over SW. slope.

83.86 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, on the W. bdy. of the Tp., previously described.

Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay with numerous rock bluffs. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, maple, chinquapin and madrone; undergrowth, huckleberry, salal, Oregon grape, hazel, ocean spray, dogwood, rhododendron, chinquapin, manzanita and vine maple.
