No mineral deposits were noted, but there is rather extensive quarrying of rock for road material.

The average of a considerable number of readings over all parts of the area resurveyed gives a value of $20^{\circ}07'$ East for mean magnetic declination. There is a range of $2^{\circ}49'$ in local attraction.
