## Dependent Resurvey of Portion of the Subdivisional Lines of T. 29 S., R. 6 W.

## CHAINS

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 6° W., 23 lks. dist.,  
mkd. E 1/16 S6 BT.

A cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 22° E., 4 lks. dist.,  
mkd. E 1/16 S7 BT.

Ascend 75 ft. over NE. slope.

26.30 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 180 ft. over broken W. slope.

31.30 Small draw, drains NW.

36.30 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.

37.95 Draw, drains N. 25° W.; asc. 7 ft. over NE. slope.

39.35 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 70 ft. over NW. slope, to creek.

42.10 Woven wire fence, bears N. 20° E. and S. 20° W.; enter open field.

43.60 Kent Creek, 5 lks. wide, 6 ins. deep, course N. 20° E.; asc. 10 ft.  
over SE. slope.

44.74 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 7, at proportionate  
distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the  
ground, with brass cap mkd.

mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S6 BT.

A chinquapin, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 28° W., 26 lks. dist.,  
mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 BT.

Ascend 16 ft. over SE. slope.

47.15 Kent Creek Road, 40 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.; asc. 585 ft.  
over SE. slope, through widely scattering timber.

76.80 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 57 ft. over broken NW. slope,  
through medium timber.

81.45 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 295 ft. over broken NW. slope.

89.10 Draw, drains N.; asc. 75 ft. over NE. slope.

91.50 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7, and 12, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.,  
monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. above ground,  
firmly set, marked and witnessed as described in the official
