Dependent Resurvey of 6th Stan. Par. S., Portion of N. Bdy. of T. 28 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay and clay loam.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, madrone, oak, and yew; undergrowth,
young timber, salal, huckleberry, manzanita, ceanothus, arrowwood,
rhododendron, Oregon grape, vines, ferns, and grass.

N. 88° 05' W., on the N. bdy. of sec. 5.

Ascend 30 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

0.65 Point for the cor. of secs. 32 and 33 only, on the S. bdy. of
T. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ S., R. 8 W.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the
ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap
mkd.

4.20 Spur, slopes N. 10° W.; desc. 25 ft. along N. slope.

8.20 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N. 20° E.; asc. 205 ft. over steep NE.
slope.

14.20 Spur, slopes N. 10° W.; desc. 15 ft. along N. slope.

25.30 Slope changes; desc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.

27.20 Spring, 6 ft. diam., drains North.

33.60 Ravine, drains N. 35° W.; asc. 100 ft. over NE. slope.

40.67 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 32 only, on the S. bdy. of
T. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ S., R. 8 W.
