59.28	Point for W. 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 32.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 86 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 45 lks. dist., mkd. W 1/16 S29 BT.
	A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. W 1/16 S32 BT.
	Ascend 488 ft. over E. slope, changing to SE. slope.
79.04	The cor. of secs. 29, 30, 31 and 32.
	Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, chinquapin, and madrone; undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, salmonberry, coast huckleberry, red huckleberry, ceanothus, salal and fern.
	S. 89° 26' W., bet. secs. 30 and 31.
	Ascend 55 ft. along S. slope, through light timber and heavy undergrowth.
8.25	Ridge, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.; desc. 34 ft. over broken W.
