CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which a new bearing tree:

A fir, 56 ins. diam., bears N.  $72\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  E., 509 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S29 BT.

No other suitable bearing tree available.

The **SE**, bearing tree and the iron post, established in 1945, were removed during construction of a fire road. No evidence was found of the iron post, however, the **SE**. bearing tree, which is a sawed fir stump, 42 ins. diam., dozed out of its original position but standing upright, bears N.  $43^\circ$  W., 68 lks. dist., with scribe marks  $\frac{1}{4}$  S29 BT visible on unhealed blaze, which is on the present SW. face of the stump.

The cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17 and 18, determined at record bearing and distance from each of the bearing trees marked in 1945:

A sawed fir stump, 26 ins. diam., bears N.  $31^\circ$  E., 35 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on burned blaze.

A decayed fir stump, 28 ins. diam., bears S.  $54\frac{1}{4}^\circ$  E., 48 lks. dist., with scribe marks T21S R8W S17 BT visible.

A fallen and decayed fir, size indeterminate, bears S.  $57\frac{3}{4}^\circ$  W., 131 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.

A sawed fir stump, 43 ins. diam., bears N.  $17^\circ$  W., 134 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.  $68^\circ$  E., 323 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R8W BT.

A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears S.  $54\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  E., 229 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R8W S17 BT.

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.  $81\frac{1}{2}^\circ$  W., 130 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R8W S18 BT.

A fir, 33 ins. diam., bears N.  $49^\circ$  W., 139 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R8W S7 BT.
