Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 21 S., R. 11 W.

CHAINS

A maple, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 17° E., 119 lks. dist.,
mkd. W 1/16 S15 BT.

A maple, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 7° W., 55 lks. dist.,
mkd. W 1/16 S22 BT.

Descend 30 ft. along S. slope.

- 61.40 Wet ravine, course N.75°W.; desc. 205 ft. along N. slope.
- 72.60 Branch, 4 lks. wide, course N. 15° W.; asc. 168 ft. over E. slope.
- 78.50 Spur, slopes N. 40° E.; asc. 22 ft. along N. slope.
- 79.88 The cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21, and 22.

Land, mountainous.
Soil, sandy clay loam.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, dogwood, cascara, and
chinquapin; undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, coast
huckleberry, red huckleberry, hazel, arrowwood, salal, and fern.

From the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28.

S. 87° 41' W., bet. secs. 21 and 28.

Descend 88 ft. over W. slope, through heavy timber and dense
undergrowth.

- 1.50 Enter bottom of mouth of large ravine, draining S.
- 6.00 Leave bottom; asc. 240 ft. over broken SE. slope.
- 23.50 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 245 ft. over broken SW. slope.
- 37.50 Branch, 3 lks. wide, course S. 30° W.; cross level land.
- 39.05 Gravelled road, 25 lks. wide, bears S. 80° E. and W.
- 39.35 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 28, at proportionate
distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the
ground, in shoulder of road, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N.33 3/4° E., 100 lks. dist.,
mkd. 1/4 S21 BT.

An alder, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 86° E., 74 lks. dist.,
mkd. 1/4 S28 BT.

At this point leave timber and enter Otter Slough bottom, edge
bears generally N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.; desc. 10 ft. across bottom.

- 55.00 Otter Slough, 50 lks. wide, course NW.; continue across bottom.
- 57.80 Leave bottom; asc. 160 ft. over broken NE. slope.
- 64.00 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 80 ft. over NW. slope.
- 71.00 Ravine, course N.; asc. 85 ft. over NE. slope.
