A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S. $68\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 28 lks. dist., mkd.
T20S R8W S2 BT.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. $49\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 54 lks. dist., mkd.
T19S R8W S35 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, heavy fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, dogwood,
chinquapin, and madrona.

Undergrowth, dense vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, salal, salmonberry,
poison oak, and bracken.

N. $89^{\circ} 13'$ W., between secs. 2 and 35.

Ascend 75 ft. along SE. slope; through heavy timber and dense
undergrowth.

4.00 Top of high spur, slopes NE.; descend 168 ft. over NW. slope.

8.10 Dry ravine, drains NW.; ascend 22 ft. over NE. slope.

10.20 Top of spur, slopes NW.; descend 230 ft. over NW. slope.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap mkd.
