| 16.96  | A dry draw, drains NE.; ascend 135 ft. over NE. slope.  |
| 19.55  | A low spur, slopes NE.; continue ascent, 57 ft.   |
| 24.50  | Top of spur, slopes NW.; descend 459 ft. over SW. slope to Esmond Creek.  |
| 33.70  | Top of spur, slopes W.  |
| 35.00  | Slope changes to NW.  |
| 38.00  | Esmond Creek, 15 lks. wide, course S. 85° W.; thence over bottom land along bank of creek.  |
| 40.18  | The cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34 and 35.<br><br>Land, mountainous, very broken.<br>Soil, rocky clay.<br>Timber, heavy fir, hemlock, alder, cedar, dogwood, maple and yew.<br>Undergrowth, very dense salmonberry, vine maple, hazel, salal, huckleberry and bracken.  |

| 7.20   | Slope changes to SW.  |
| 11.95  | A trail, bears NW. and SE.  |
| 13.80  | Top of divide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; descend 275 ft. over NE. slope.   |
| 19.60  | Top of spur, slopes NE.; slope changes to N.  |
| 22.75  | A dry draw, drains NE.; ascend 41 ft. along SE. slope, changing to E.   |
| 25.40  | Top of spur, slopes NE.; descend 106 ft. over NE. slope.  |
| 27.60  | A dry draw, drains E.; ascend 153 ft. over SE. slope, changing to S.  |
| 31.10  | Top of spur, slopes E.; descend 164 ft. over NE. slope.   |
| 34.15  | Head of ravine, drains E.; ascend 122 ft. over SE. slope, changing to south.  |
| 38.80  | Top of spur, slopes NE.; descend 34 ft. over N. slope.  |
| 40.57  | The $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. of secs. 33 and 34, mkd. by the root hole of the original tree corner which is fallen but still shows a healed blaze on the former W. side, from which the original bearing trees:<br><br>A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears N. 68° E., 27 lks. dist., mkd. with a healed blaze facing SW. |
