

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivision, T. 19 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

N. 0° 29' E., beginning new measurement.

Ascend slightly.

0.25 Top of ridge, bears N. 15° W., and S. 70° E.; descend 238 ft. over NE. slope.

5.60 Bottom of dry draw, drains NE.; ascend 90 ft. along broken NE. slope.

14.90 Top of spur, slopes NE.; descend 392 ft. over NE. slope.

25.00 Bottom of draw, drains NE.; descend 9 ft.

26.85 A spring branch, 3 lks. wide, course SE.; ascend 367 ft. over broken SW. slope.

41.23 Point for the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, determined from the remains of the original bearing trees:

A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears S. 44° 45' E., 41 lks. dist., scribed R8 on nearly healed old blaze.

A fir stump, badly decayed, bears S. 69° W., 79 lks. dist., (Record is 82 lks. dist.)

A fir stump bears north, 112 lks. dist., evidently the stump of the line tree noted in the record.

AT the corner point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 38 ins. diam., bears N. 83¼° E., 62 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R8W S 4 BT.

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 40° 45' E., 75 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R8W S 9 BT.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 64½° W., 21 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R8W S 8 BT.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 47½° W., 84 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R8W S 5 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, heavy fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, maple, dogwood, madrona, and yew.

Undergrowth, dense vine maple, hazel, salal, arrowwood, rhododendron, manzanita, slickleaf, bracken and poison oak.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.

N. 87° 35' W., between secs. 4 and 9.

Descend 125 ft. over W. slope.

5.00 Foot of descent, bears N. and S.; thence over nearly level bottom land.
