Dependent Resurvey of the E. Bdy., T. 19 S., R. 8 W.

2.50	A ridge, bears N. and S. 15° E.; desc. 60 ft. along top of ridge.
5.00	Leave ridge, bears N. 25° E. and S.; desc. 30 ft. over NW. slope.
5.50	The head of a ravine, course NW.; descend 52 ft. along broken W. slope.
8.65	The head of a ravine, course W.; ascend 81 ft. over SW. slope.
13.05	Same ridge, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.; desc. 243 ft. over N. slope.
17.75	A ravine, course N. 50° E.; ascend 280 ft. over SE. slope.
27.00	Same ridge, and a blazed trail, bear N. 60° E. and S. 60° W.; descend 346 ft. over NW. slope, changing to N. slope.
33.70	The head of a ravine, course NW.; ascend 19 ft. over SW. slope.
35.17	Point for the closing cor. of secs. 30 and 31, T. 19 W., R. 7 W.; ascend 15 ft. over SW. slope.
36.70	A spur, slopes N. 60° W.; descend 156 ft. over NE. slope.
40.14	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 25 only, determined at the record bearing and distance from each of the original bearing trees as follows: A down fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S. $33\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 48 lks. dist., with blaze burned. A maple stump in maple stool, 16 ins. diam., bears S. $54^{\circ}45'$ W., 9 lks. dist., with blaze badly decayed. At the corner point Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 25 1949 from which new bearing trees A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. $80^{\circ}45'$ W., 41 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S25 BT. A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. $7\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 149 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S25 BT. N. $0^{\circ}23'$ E., beginning new measurement. Descend 8 ft. over NE. slope, changing to N. slope.
0.40	A ravine, course NW.; ascend 148 ft. over SW. slope.
5.60	A spur, slopes SW.; ascend 174 ft. along W. slope, changing to SW. slope.
15.75	A ridge, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.; descend 73 ft. over NE. slope.
18.00	The head of a ravine, course E.; ascend 114 ft. over SE. slope.
24.50	Same ridge, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.; descend 2 ft. along top of ridge.
26.50	Leave ridgetop; descend 228 ft. along W. slope, changing to NW. slope.
33.90	The head of a ravine, course W.; ascend 95 ft. over SW. slope.
