Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 23 S., R. 1 W.

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit original corner stone alongside iron post.

N. 0° 34' E., bet. secs. 25 and 26, marking and blazing the true line.

Descend 445 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

25.20 Creek, 10 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 297 ft. over SE. slope.

36.20 Top of ascent, slopes E.; desc. 260 ft. over NE. slope.

37.67 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 26, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 44 ins. diam., bears S. 57° E., 9 lks. dist., mkd. ¼ S25 BT.

A hemlock, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 57° W., 44 lks. dist., Mkd. ¼ S26 BT.

Descend 34 ft. over NE. slope.

45.30 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 380 ft. over SE. slope.

52.80 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 48 ft. over NE. slope.

60.15 Bottom of descent, slopes E.; asc. 78 ft. over SE. slope.

62.20 Top of ascent, slopes E.; desc. 36 ft. over NE. slope.

66.69 Ravine, course E.; asc. 338 ft. over SE. slope.

75.34 The cor. of secs. 23, 24, 25, and 26, monumented with the original basalt stone, 12 x 10 x 8 ins. firmly set, 4 ins. above the ground, with 2 notches on the S. and 1 notch on the E. edge, from which the original bearing trees:

A cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 82½° E., 118 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 45 ins. diam., bears S. 4° E., 64 lks. dist., with healed blaze. (Record distance, 77 lks.)

A down and rotted cedar, bears S. 58° W., 129 lks. dist., no mks. remaining.

A madrone, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 19° W., 54 lks. dist., with a healed blaze. (Record bearing, N. 23° W.)
