29.33	Foot of descent, slopes E.; ascend 57 ft. over SE. slope.
36.07	Spur ridge, bears NW. and SE.; descend 13 ft. over NE. slope.
37.42	Enter swamp, edge bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; continue across swamp which drains SE.
39.55	Leave swamp, edge bears NW. and SE.; ascend 5 ft. over S. slope.

9.72	Enter burned and logged area, edge bears N. and W.
21.40	Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; descend 363 ft. over NW. slope.
21.90	Dirt access road, 15 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.
35.00	Enter dense reproduction, edge bears S. and W.
