A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears S. $58\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 248 lks. dist., mkd.
T21S R3W S31 BT.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears S. $84\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 181 lks. dist., mkd.
T21S R4W S36 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. $21\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., $51\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd.
T21S R4W S25 BT.

Reset iron pipe alongside the iron post.

Corner falls on spur ridge bearing E. and W.

S. $89^{\circ} 30'$ W., between secs. 25 and 36.

Ascend 68 ft. over E. slope, though open burned area.

14.12 Top of flat ridge, bears N. 70° W. and E.; descend 142 ft. over
W. slope, through scattering timber and reproduction.

25.00 Spring seepage, course S.; ascend 18 ft. along S. slope.

27.05 Dirt access road, 15 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.

35.57 Spring, course SE.; ascend 35 ft. over SE. slope.

36.27 Spring, course SE.; ascend 35 ft. over SE. slope.

40.205 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36, at proportionate
distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{8}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the
ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. $53\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 113 lks. dist., mkd.
 $\frac{1}{4}$ S36 BT.

From this point a locally established cor. bears S. 33° W., 11 lks.
dist., monumented with a fir stake, 2 ins. sq., protruding 40 ins.
above ground, firmly set, mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on all sides.
