Dependent Resvy. of a Portion of the Subd. Lines, T. 23 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

- 63.19 Foot of descent, slopes S.; leave timber, enter logged area, edge bears N. & S.; asc. 29 ft. over SE. slope.
- 67.04 Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 196 ft. over SW. slope.
- 80.29 Abandoned skid road, 15 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.
- 81.57 Top of steep rock slope, edge bears NW. and SE.; desc. 47 ft. over SW. slope.
- 83.61 The corner of sections 2, 3, 10 and 11.
- Land, mountainous.
Soil, clay loam and rocky clay loam.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, chinquapin, cascara, dogwood, and wild cherry.
Undergrowth, salal, vine maple, arrowwood, Oregon grape, rhododendron, hazel, huckleberry and blackberry.

- From the corner of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23.
- S. 89° 45' W., bet. secs. 15 and 22.
- Descend 239 ft. over general NW. slope, along S. edge of logged area through scattered timber and undergrowth.
- 17.19 Bar Creek, 3 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 282 ft. over NE. slope.
- 29.61 Dirt access road; 20 lks. wide, bears N. and SE.
- 29.92 Leave logged area, enter heavy timber, edge bears N. and E.
- 34.63 Ridge, dividing Big River drainage and Little River drainage, bears N. and S. 30° E.; desc. 49 ft. over W. slope.
- 40.25 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 22, determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees:
- A rotted hemlock stump, 5 ins. diam., bears North, 5 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on piece of old face lying at the base of the stump.
- A down and rotted hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 15° W., 5 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on old face.
- At the corner point.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

- A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 47° W., 105 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S15 BT.
- A hemlock, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 23 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S22 BT.

- N. 88° 27' W., beginning new measurement.
- Descend 121 ft. over W. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
