

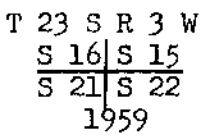
# County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 23 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

- 6.54 Branch, 1 lk. wide, course SW.; asc. 10 ft. over SE. slope.
- 12.32 Top of ascent, slopes SW.; desc. 555 ft. over SW. slope.
- 35.87 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 122 ft. over E. slope.
- 49.01 Point for the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.



from which

- A cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 17° E., 104½ lks. dist., mkd. T23S R3W S15 BT.
- A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 48¾° E., 29 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R3W S22 BT.
- A hemlock, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 67° W., 30 lks. dist., mkd. T23S R3W S21 BT.
- A hemlock, 9 ins. diam., bears N. 69° W., 43 lks. dist., Mkd. T23S R3W S16 BT.

From this point the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 22, bears S. 6° 12' W., 38.68 chs. dist., determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original SE. bearing tree and substantiated by two bearing trees marked and recorded by G. A. Gardner, Registered Surveyor, in 1954.

from which the original bearing tree

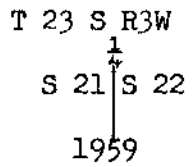
- A burned and rotted fir stump, 33 ins. diam., bears S. 65° E., 40 lks. dist., no marks remaining.

and bearing trees by Gardner

- A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 22½° E., 12 lks. dist., with scribe marks ¼ S BT visible on a partially healed blaze.
- A cedar, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 48¼° W., 59½ lks. dist., with scribe marks ¼ S BT visible on a partially healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.



From the same point the cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20 and 21, bears N. 89° 02' W., 80.55 chs. dist., perpetuated and recorded by C. M. Collier, County Surveyor, 1908, from the four original bearing trees, of which only one remains; monumented with a stone, 26 x 12 x 12 ins., firmly set, mkd. with 4 notches on E. edge.

From which the remaining original bearing trees.
