

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of the S. Bdy., T. 19 S., R. 7 W.

CHAINS

- 28.50 Left bank of Siuslaw River; asc. 12 ft. over cut bank; thence asc. 11 ft. across bottom land.
- 40.57 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 34, determined at the record bearing and distance from the original SE. bearing tree, as follows:
- A white fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 10° E.; 30 lks. dist., with partial scribe mks. visible on deaying face of blaze.
- At the corner point.
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked
- $\frac{1}{4}$ S 34

- A hemlock, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 72° E., 47 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT.
- A fir, 78 ins. diam., bears N. $53^{\circ} 45'$ W., 18 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S34 BT.
- The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. is located at edge of bottom, which bears NE. and SW.
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- N. $89^{\circ} 29'$ W., beginning new measurement.
- Ascend 114 ft. along broken S. slope.
- 17.85 Top of ascent on S. slope; desc. 34 ft. over SW. slope.
- 23.05 A ravine, course S.; asc. 71 ft. over broken SE. slope.
- 28.40 The head of a ravine, course SE.; asc. 238 ft. over SE. slope.
- 35.75 A spur, slopes S.; desc. 74 ft. over SW. slope.
- 39.60 The cor. of secs. 33 and 34, determined at the record bearing from the original NE. bearing tree and the record bearing and distance from the original NW. bearing tree as follows:
- A maple, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 45° E., 15 lks. dist., with evident axe marks on decayed old blaze. (Record 18 lks. dist.)
- A maple, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 30° W., 32 lks. dist., with evident axe marks on decayed old blaze.
- At the corner point
- Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground with brass cap marked

- A fir, 50 ins. diam., bears N. $60\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 11 lks. dist., marked T19S R7W S33 BT.
- Land, mountainous and rolling.
- Soil, sandy clay loam.
- Timber, fir, hemlock, maple, cedar, white fir, alder, chinquapin, dogwood, and madrona.
- Undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, salal, willow, & bracken.
