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Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the W. Bdy. of T. 19 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. $83\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 39 lks. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S24 BT.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. $34\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 78 lks. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S24 BT.

Ascend 45 ft. along E. slope.

20.545 Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 18 only.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which

A maple, 20 ins. diam., bears N. $32\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 67 lks. dist., mkd. S 1/16 S18 BT.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. $24\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 101 lks. dist., mkd. S 1/16 S18 BT.

Continue along broken E. slope.

23.05 Spur, slopes S. 80° E.; desc. 60 ft. over NE. slope.

29.30 Spring branch, 2 lks. wide, course S. 80° E.; asc. 200 ft. over SE. slope.

38.05 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 5 ft. over NE. slope.

38.57 Point for the closing corner of secs. 13 and 24, T. 19 S., R. 9 W., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an ironpost, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. $28\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 48 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R9W S13 CC BT.

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S. $78\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 31 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R9W S24 CC BT.

Descend 50 ft. over NE. slope.

40.05 Intermittent spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course S. 60° E., from W.; ascend 30 ft. over SE. slope.

41.09 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 18 only, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the orig. corner.
