42.80	Spur, slopes N. 80° E.; desc. 160 ft. over broken N. slope.
46.40	Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, course N. 60° E.; asc. 180 ft. over broken SE. slope.
54.70	Spur, slopes N. 85° E.; desc. 340 ft. over broken NE. slope.
62.10	Ravine, course E.; asc. 120 ft. over broken SE. slope.
66.00	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 180 ft. over broken NE. slope.
73.20	Gold Creek, 14 lks. wide, course SE.; asc. 30 ft. over broken W. slope.

81.21	Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.  Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	An alder, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 47° E.; 3 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R9W S36 BT.
	A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 18° W., 81 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R9W S35 BT.
	A fir, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 60° W., 36 lks. dist., mkd. T19S R9W S26 BT.
	From this point, the cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24, hereinafter described, bears N. 1° 00' W., 162.42 chains distant.
	Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, cascara, dogwood, madrona, and yew. Undergrowth, vine maple, salmonberry, red huckleberry, evergreen huckleberry, hazel, arrowwood, and sword fern.
