Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the Subdivisional Lines, T. 23 S., R. 7 W.

## CHAINS

A white oak, 32 ins. diam., bears S.  $79\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  W., 43 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A sawed fir stump, 48 ins. diam., bears N.  $72^{\circ}$  W., 134 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on bark.

I do not remonument this corner.

There is no remaining evidence of any of the original meander corners which were established on this mile of line.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, alder, oak, chinquapin, and madrone; undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, arrowwood, salmonberry, huckleberry, blackberry, salal, poison oak, and fern.

N.  $0^{\circ} 05'$  E., bet. secs. 22 and 23.

Descend 107 ft. over NE. slope, through open pasture land.

15.85 Maupin Road, gravel surfaced, 25 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.

30.30 Left bank of Umpqua River, bears NW. and SE., course NW.

38.85 Right bank of Umpqua River, enter timber; asc. 5 ft. over river bank.

39.00 Point for a witness point of secs. 22 and 23.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Ascend 13 ft. over SW. slope.

40.62 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 23, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the orig. corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A myrtle, 8 ins. diam., bears S.  $32^{\circ}$  E.,  $44\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S23 BT.

A myrtle, 8 ins. diam., bears N.  $4^{\circ}$  W., 66 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S22 BT.

From this point a cor. established by Wilford N. Haines bears N.  $75^{\circ}$  W., 0.03 chs. dist., monumented with a 1 in. T. iron, firmly set, projecting 3 ins. above ground, with an aluminum cap mkd.
