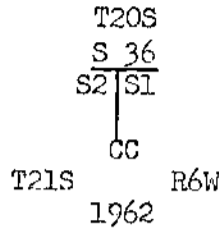


County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 21 S., R. 6 W.

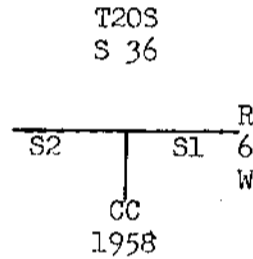

from which

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S. 77° E., 125 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R6W S1 CC BT.

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 115 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R6W S2 CC BT.

From this point the original closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, bears N. 0° 02' E., 0.12 chs. dist., perpetuated with a Douglas County survey marker, an iron post, 1 in. diam., protruding 8 ins. from the ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd.



from which the remaining original bearing trees:

A sawed fir stump, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 52½° W., 15 lks. dist., with axe marks visible on old face. (Record bearing, N. 59° W.)

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 80° W., 24 lks. dist., mkd. S2 T21S R6W BT.

trees mkd. by the County Surveyor:

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 16½° E., 42 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on partially healed blaze.

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears E., 14 lks. dist., mkd. T21S R6W CC S1 CS BT.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 80° W., 24 lks. dist., mkd. CC S2 T21S R6W CS BT. (Remarked original bearing tree.)

I add the marks AM to the original bearing trees.

Land, rolling hills and mountainous.

Soil, loam and clay.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, maple, chinquapin, madrone, alder, willow, and dogwood; undergrowth, vine maple, arrowwood, manzanita, hazel, and poison oak.

The point for the ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 1 only, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., is at midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 1.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
