the section. It is used as a sheep shearing station during the season. In the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ a small shack was inhabited by a hunter and his pack of coon hounds.

No evidence of mineral deposits was noted during the course of the resurvey.

The average of a considerable number of readings over all parts of the section gives a value of 20° 18' E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of 0° 48' in local attraction.
