Subdivision of Section 21, T. 23 S., R. 7 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $20\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E., $44\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., marked SMC S21 BT. *Per research 6-20-96 (D.C.S.C.)*

From this point the meander cor. of secs. 21 and 22, on the left bank of the Umpqua River, bears S. $15^{\circ} 05'$ E., 18.67 chs. dist., heretofore described.

From the center W $1/16$ sec. cor. of sec. 21.

N. $0^{\circ} 07'$ E., along the N. and S., center line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 21.

Ascend 153 ft. over broken general S. slope, through light timber and dense undergrowth.

13.00 Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 84 ft. over NW. slope.

19.76 Point for the NW $1/16$ sec. cor. of sec. 21, at intersection with the E. and W. center line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

NW $1/16$ S 21

from which

A maple, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 76° W., 8 lks. dist., marked NW $1/16$ S21 BT.

A maple, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 5° E., 31 lks. dist., marked NW $1/16$ S21 BT.

Descend 125 ft. over NW. slope.

22.90 Ravine, drains N. 30° E.; asc. 56 ft. over SE. slope.

27.55 Top of ascent, slopes E.; desc. 130 ft. over NE. slope.

32.20 Creek, 4 lks. wide course SE.; asc. 97 ft. over S. slope.

33.40 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 55° W. and S. 55° E.; center open pasture land, edge bears same as road.

39.55 The W $1/16$ sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21, monumented with an iron post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, 4 ins. below surface of gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bearing NW. and SE., marked and witnessed as described in the official record.

From the center N $1/16$ sec. cor. of sec. 21.

N. $88^{\circ} 22'$ W., along the E. and W. center line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 21.

Descend 33 ft. over W. slope, through light timber and dense undergrowth.

0.60 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 35° W. and S. 35° E.

1.60 Creek, 8 lks. wide, course N. 25° W.; asc. 33 ft. over NE. slope.

2.80 Spur, slopes N. 20° E.; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.
