

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of W. Bdy., T. 31 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S.  $52^{\circ}$  E., 40 lks. dist., scribe marks visible on bark blaze. Remarked T31S R 8W S19 BT.

A rotted fir stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S.  $69^{\circ}$  W., 36 lks. dist., no marks remain. (Record bearing, S.  $74^{\circ}$  W.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 62 ins. diam., bears N.  $26\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 63 lks. dist., bark scribed T31S R8W S18 BT.

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S.  $32^{\circ}$  W., 54 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R9W S24 BT.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N.  $88^{\circ}$  W., 100 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R9W S13 BT.

Soil, rocky clay. Land, mountainous.

Timber, fir, hemlock, oak, cedar, pine and madrone; undergrowth, salal, Oregon grape, live oak, vine maple, hazel, rhododendron, ferns and vines.

N.  $0^{\circ}$  17' W., bet. secs. 13 and 18.

Descend 270 ft. along broken W. slope, through old logged area.

26.00 Spur, slopes N.  $70^{\circ}$  W.; desc. 165 ft. over NW. slope.

31.35 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S.  $65^{\circ}$  W.; asc. 105 over SW. slope.

33.20 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears E., curving N.  $65^{\circ}$  E., and W.

39.06 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18, determined at record distance from the original bearing trees:

A fir, 37 ins. diam., bears N.  $53\text{-}3/4^{\circ}$  E., 18 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT on bark blaze, remarked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S18 BT on bark blaze. (Record bearing, N.  $64^{\circ}$  E.)

A fir, 31 ins. diam., bears S.  $48\text{-}3/4^{\circ}$  W., 14 lks. dist., visible scribe marks on bark blaze, remarked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S13 BT. (Record bearing, S.  $43^{\circ}$  W.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked.
