

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of W. Bdy., T. 31 S., R. 8 W.

CHAINS

A forked fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 40° E.,
40 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R8W S6 BT on old bark
blaze.

A fir stump, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 35° E., 38
lks. dist., mkd. W. on bark blaze. (Record
bearing, S. 41° E.)

A fir snag, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 58° W., 35 lks.
dist., bark scribing visible, not legible.
(Record bearing, S. 62° W.)

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 42½° W., 40 lks.
dist., mkd. T31S R9W S1 on bark blaze. Remarkd
T31S R9W S1 BT. (Record bearing, N. 40° W.)

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 19° E., 41 lks.
dist., mkd. T31S R8W S6 BT.

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 47° E., 53 lks.
dist., mkd. T31S R 8W S7 BT.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 30° W., 25 lks.
dist., mkd. T31S R9W S12 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, chinquapin, madrone,
oak and maple; undergrowth, salal, live oak, hazel,
rhododendron, poison oak, huckleberry, ferns and vines.
N. 0° 06' W., bet. secs. 1 and 6.

Ascend 580 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and
moderate undergrowth.

22.80 Top of rock bluff, 30 ft. high, bears NW. and SE.

23.80 Ridge, bears N. 80° W., and S. 80° E.; desc. 200 ft.
over NE. slope.

39.48 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, determined at record
bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing
tree:

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 85° W., 11 lks.
dist., mkd. ¼ S on partially opened blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
