Dependent Resurvey, Subdivisional Lines, T. 31 S., R. 8 W.

The cor. of secs. 16, 17, 20, and 21, perpetuated by and recorded in the County Surveyor's Office, in 1958, monumented with an iron pipe, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, firmly set, at record distance from the remaining original bearing trees, with brass cap mkd.

from which original bearing trees:

A fir snag, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 80° E., 10 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on open blaze.

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 15° E.; 24 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT visible on opened blaze. (Record bearing, S. 20° E.)

and bearing trees mkd. in 1958.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. $53\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 50 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R8W S20 CS BT on open blaze.

A fir, 32 ins. diam., bears N. $33\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 18 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R8W on partially healed blaze.

and a new bearing tree

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. $83\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 55 lks. dist., mkd. T31S R8W S16 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, pine, madrone, cedar, hemlock, live oak, chinquapin, dogwood; undergrowth, young timber, salal, Oregon grape, rhododendron, manzanita, poison oak, huckleberry, black raspberry, vine maple, ferns and vines.

From the cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16.

S $89^{\circ} 35'$ W., bet. secs. 9 and 16.

Ascend 10 ft. along S. slope, through heavy timber and moderate undergrowth.

0.30 Spur, slopes S. 10° E., asc. 160 ft. along broken S. slope.

14.50 Ravine, drains S. 60° E.; asc. 190 ft. along N. slope.

19.15 Spur, slopes SE.; asc. 360 ft. over broken SE. slope.

38.31 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 9 and 16, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
