5.30	Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 65 ft. over broken NW. slope.
12.55	Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. $10^{\circ}$ E.; asc. 170 ft. over NE. slope.
19.60	Dirt road to Dutchman Butte Lookout, 20 lks. wide, bears N. $45^{\circ}$ W. and S. $30^{\circ}$ W. on curve.
21.00	Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 5 ft. over NW. slope.
24.00	Ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 320 ft. over SW. slope.
32.00	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. $50^{\circ}$ W.; asc. 20 ft. over N. slope.
