Remonumentation of Certain Original Corner Points, T. 25 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

A broken hemlock stump, 7 ins. diam., bears S. 30° W., 6 lks. dist., with scribe mark 4 visible on opened blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked

from which a new bearing tree

A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 44° W., 106 lks. dist., marked ¼ S16 BT.

Deposit the original corner stone alongside the iron post.

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 8 and 9, monumented with a basalt stone, 20 x 10 x 8 ins., firmly set 15 ins. in the ground, marked ¼ on the W. face, from which the original bearing trees:

A hemlock, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 70° E., 10 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A dogwood crown, bears S. 30½° W., 13 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks, in negative, visible on rotted trunk.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which a new bearing tree

A white pine, 19 ins. diam., bears N. 49¼° W., 25 lks. dist., marked ¼ S8 BT.

Deposit the original corner stone alongside the iron post.

The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, monumented with a basalt stone, 16 x 9 x 8 ins., loosely set 6 ins. in the ground, marked ¼ on the W. face, from which the original bearing trees:

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 60° E., 35 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

A white pine, 50 ins. diam., bears N. 40° W., 10 lks. dist., with a healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked
