16.90	Foot of descent; asc. 43 ft. over NE. slope.
18.25	Spur, slopes N. 30° W., desc. 155 ft. over NW. slope.
22.70	Foot of descent; asc. 79 ft. over N. slope.
26.57	Spur, slopes N. 50° W.; desc. 121 ft. over NW. slope.
30.05	Spring branch, course N. 30° W.; asc. 76 ft. over E. slope.
33.28	Spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 16 ft. over NW. slope.
36.54	Foot of descent; asc. 84 ft. over N. slope.

40.75	Spur, slopes N.; desc. 76 ft. over NW. slope.
44.15	Foot of descent; asc. 65 ft. over NE. slope.
46.57	Spur, slopes N. 60° W.; desc. 725 ft. over SW. slope.
63.70	Dry branch, 3 lks wide, course N. 65° W.; asc. 44 ft. over NE. slope.
68.34	Spur, slopes N. 60° W.; desc. 359 ft. over NW. slope.
76.34	The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36.  Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, sugar pine, yew, madrone, chinquapin, and dogwood; undergrowth, vine maple, salal, huckleberry, and Oregon grape.
	From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.  N. 15° 36' E., bet. secs. 34 and 35.  Descend 16 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
