A fir snag, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 18° W., 56 lks. dist., mkd. BT on an opened blaze.

A cedar snag, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 26° 10' W., 15 lks. dist., mkd. with an opened blaze.

and bearing trees marked by Byron:

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 44 3/4° W., 167 lks. dist., mkd. T24S R6W S8 CS BT, on an open blaze.

A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 70° W., 180 lks. dist., mkd. T24S R6W S5 CS BT, on an open blaze.

and a new bearing tree,

A sawed cedar stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 75° E., 126 lks. dist., mkd. T24S R6W S9 BT.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, madrone, maple, oak, myrtle, alder, and yew; undergrowth, young timber, hazel, ceanothus, salal, huckleberry, greasewood, scotch broom, Oregon grape, blackberries, arrowwood, vines, ferns, and grass.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lines of this resurvey are located in mountainous terrain, in Douglas County, about ten miles northwest of the city of Sutherlin, Oregon. The area is reached by way of logging roads from Yellow Creek Road and State Highway No. 225. The elevation ranges from about 1,050 feet to about 2,100 feet above sea level.
