CHAINS Dependent Resurvey, Subdivisional Lines, T. 24 S., R. 8 W.

Descend 295 ft. over N. slope, changing to NW. slope.

49.60 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 495 ft. over NW. slope.

70.50 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N.20° E.; continue over creek bottom.

73.00 Leave creek bottom; asc. 75 ft. over SE.slope.

79.08 Point for the cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 33½° E., 57 lks. dist., mkd. T24S R8W S33 BT.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W., 26 lks. dist., mkd. T24S R8W S32 BT.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 44° W., 6 lks. dist., mkd. T24S R8W S29 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, madrone, chinquapin, maple, cedar, alder and yew; undergrowth, rhododendron, salal, huckleberry, vine maple, arrowwood, salmonberry, and fern.

From the cor. of secs. 27, 28, 33 and 34.

S. 89° 08' W., bet. secs. 28 and 33.

Descend 10 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and moderate undergrowth.

0.80 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S. 30° E.; asc. 5 ft. over broken SE. slope.

2.40 Spring, 1 lk. wide, drains S. 30° E.; asc. 310 ft. over broken SE. slope, changing to E. slope.

14.40 Spur, slopes S. 30° E.; desc. 5 ft. over SW.slope.

15.85 Draw, drains S. 15° E.; asc. 80 ft. over SE. slope.

18.40 Spur, slopes S. 20° E.; desc. 20 ft. over SW. slope.

20.70 Draw, drains S. 10° E.; asc. 70 ft. over SE. slope.

24.25 Spur ridge, bears N. 65° E. and S. 65° W.; desc. 325 ft. along N. slope, changing to NW. slope.
