CHAINS

Dependent Resurvey, Subdivisional Lines, T. 24 S., R. 8 W.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S.  $32\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 45 lks.  
dist., mkd. T24S R8W S32 BT.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S.  $36^{\circ}$  W., 44 lks.  
dist., mkd. T24S R8W S31 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.  $50^{\circ}$  W.,  $14\frac{1}{2}$  lks.  
dist., mkd. T24S R8W S30 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay, loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, madrone, alder, chinquapin,  
and maple; undergrowth, young timber, salal, rhododendron,  
Oregon grape, huckleberry, arrowwood, vine maple, poison  
oak, hazel, ferns, and manzanita.

N.  $1^{\circ}$  16' W., bet. secs. 29 and 30.

Descend 75 ft. along W. slope, through heavy timber and  
moderate undergrowth.

3.35 Bateman Lookout Road, 20 lks. wide, bears N.  $10^{\circ}$  E. and  
S.  $15^{\circ}$  W.

9.20 Bottom of descent, slopes W.; asc. 65 ft. along W. slope.

17.65 Ridge, bears N.  $30^{\circ}$  W. and S.  $30^{\circ}$  E., also Bateman Look-  
out Road, bears N.  $30^{\circ}$  W. and S.  $15^{\circ}$  E.; desc. 165 ft.  
over NE. slope.

22.45 Ravine, drains E.; asc. 140 ft. over SE. slope.

27.25 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 55 ft. over NE. slope.

30.15 Draw, drains E.; asc. 70 ft. over SE. slope.

32.30 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 110 ft. over NE. slope.

37.00 Bottom of descent, drains E.; asc. 90 ft. over SE. slope.

40.83 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 29 and 30, determined at record  
bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing  
tree:

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S.  $27^{\circ}$  E., 69 lks.  
dist., mkd. with old face on opened blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in  
the ground, with brass cap marked

from which new bearing trees

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N.  $48\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 30 lks.  
dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S29 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.  $76^{\circ}$  W., 73 lks.  
dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S30 BT.

The cor. is located on the E. edge of the Bateman Lookout  
Road.
