Dependent Resurvey, South Boundary, T. 24 S., R. 1 W.

CHAINS

field notes of the dependent resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 24 S., R. 2 W., of this assignment.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, sugar pine, yew, madrone, chinquapin, and dogwood; undergrowth, vine maple, salal, huckleberry, and Oregon grape.

Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the East Boundary of T. 25 S., R. 2 W.

(Restoring the 1900 resurvey by Hezekiah H. Johnson)

From the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 12 only, monumented with a basalt stone, 16 x 9 x 7 ins., firmly set, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on the W. face. No trace of the original bearing trees.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which

An incense cedar, 6 ins. diam., bears N.,  $20^{\circ}$  W., 49 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S12 BT.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S.  $7^{\circ}$  W., 20 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S12 BT.

Bury the original corner stone alongside the iron post.

N.  $0^{\circ}$  18' W., along the E. bdy. of sec. 12, marking and blazing the true line.

Ascend 333 ft. over broken S. slope, along E. edge of logging.

33.52 Branch, 2 lks. wide, course S.  $30^{\circ}$  E.

40.66 Point for the cor. of secs. 1 and 12 only, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
