Soil, rocky clay loam. Timber, fir, hemlock, sugar pine, cedar, yew, madrone, chinquapin, and dogwood; undergrowth, vine maple, salal, huckleberry, Oregon grape, and rhododendron.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11. S. 89° 56' W., bet. secs. 3 and 10. Ascend 108 ft. over E. slope, along top of spur, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p>

21.04	Foot of descent; asc. 419 ft. over SE. slope.
