

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Subdivision of Section 1, T. 26 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

- 34.98 Rock Creek, 140 lks. wide, course S.  $75^{\circ}$  W.; asc. 79 ft. over S. slope.
- 39.40 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N.  $70^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $70^{\circ}$  W.
- 39.70 Woven wire fence, bears N.  $70^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $70^{\circ}$  W.
- 40.46 Point for the center  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 1, at intersection with the E. and W. center line.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 25 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

- A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S.  $86\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  E., 195 lks. dist., mkd. C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S1 BT.
- and a local bearing tree
- A cedar, 8 ins. diam., bears N.  $54\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  W., 98 lks. dist., mkd. C  $\frac{1}{4}$  S1 CS BT.
- From this point an iron pipe,  $\frac{1}{2}$  in. diam., firmly set, protruding 6 ins. above the ground, bears N.  $83^{\circ} 00'$  W., 0.30 chs. dist., at a point determined by the County Surveyor, in 1937.
- Ascend 1 ft. over S. slope.
- 43.10 Woven wire fence bears E. and W.
- 43.44 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SW.; asc. 17 ft. over SE. slope.
- 45.52 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 98 ft. over SE. slope.
- 46.34 Rock Creek Road, bituminous pavement, 32 lks. wide, bears NE. and SW.
- 53.44 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course S.  $15^{\circ}$  E.; asc. 58 ft. over SE. slope.
- 59.83 Point for the center N  $1/16$  sec. cor. of sec. 1.
- Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 21 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

- A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.  $82\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  E., 48 lks. dist., mkd. CN  $1/16$  S1 BT.
- A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.  $49\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 149 lks. dist., mkd. CN  $1/16$  S1 BT.
- From this point a wood stake, 2 ins. square, firmly set, protruding 30 ins. above the ground, bears S.  $46^{\circ} 30'$  W., 0.08 chs. dist., at a point determined by A. R. Evans, in 1954.
