

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Subdivision of Section 1, T. 26 S., R. 3 W.

CHAINS

from which

A fir snag, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 27° E., 28 lks. dist., mkd. CN 1/16 S1 BT on opened blaze.

A fir stump, 10 ins. diam., bears N. $31\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 62 lks. dist., and the fallen tree bears scribe marks CN 1/16 S1 BT.

Ascend 136 ft. over broken E. slope.

79.38 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, on the N. bdy. of the Tp.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.

N. $87^{\circ} 40'$ W., on the E. and W. center line of sec. 1.

Descend 499 ft. over NW. slope, through heavy timber and moderate undergrowth.

19.64 Point for the center E 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 1.

Set an iron pipe, 24 ins. long, 1 in. diam., 6 ins. in the rock face of precipitous slope,

from which

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. $83\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ W., 148 lks. dist., mkd. CE 1/16 S1 BT.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears S. $9\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 53 lks. dist., mkd. CE 1/16 S1 BT.

An iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S. $87^{\circ} 40'$ E., $34\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. CE 1/16 S1 RM 1963, and an arrow pointing to the corner.

An iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., set 23 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S. $0^{\circ} 36'$ W., 30 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. CE 1/16 S1 RM 1963, and an arrow pointing to the corner.

Descend 324 ft. over NW. slope.

27.57 Rock Creek, 100 lks. wide, course S.; asc. 55 ft. over E. slope.

34.75 Top of ascent, slopes S.; desc. 8 ft. over W. slope.

36.44 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.

36.96 Woven wire fence bears N. 70° E. and S. 70° W.

39.28 The center $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1.

Descend 49 ft. over W. slope, through dense reproduction

39.90 Woven wire fence bears S. and W., along the N. side of the Rock Creek Fish Hatchery.

43.47 Woven wire fence, bears N.; enter Rock Creek Fish Hatchery.
