

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey, Subdivisional Lines, T. 30 S., R. 2 W.

CHAINS

ins. above ground, firmly set, from which:

A cedar, 12 ins. diam., bears S.  $58^{\circ}$  E.,  $7\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., mkd. S23, at breast height, on open blaze.

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N.  $18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 5 lks. dist., mkd. S22, at breast height, on open blaze.

Descend 70 ft. over broken NE. slope.

27.10 Leave timber, enter area of the Dompier Creek Slide, edge bears N.  $65^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $65^{\circ}$  W.

31.20 S. edge of a small lake, bears E. and W., curving to NW.; continue across lake.

36.80 N. edge of lake, bears S.  $50^{\circ}$  E. and NW.; asc. 45 ft. over SW. slope, across huge boulders.

41.12 Point for the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23, at record distance in latitude south of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 14 and 15, and record distance in departure east of the corner of secs. 15, 16, 21, and 22, based on the 1909 resurvey by Fred Mensch.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N.  $32\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 40 lks. dist., mkd. T30S R2W S14 BT.

The NW. face of a rock ledge, 11 x 9 x 7 ft. above ground, bears S.  $70\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 23 lks. dist., mkd. B X O.

The NE. corner of a rock ledge, 36 x 21 x 7 ft. above ground, bears S.  $44\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 64 lks. dist., mkd. B X O.

No trees or objects available in section 15.

From this point the corner monument set by Mensch in 1909 at the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, and 23, bears S.  $87^{\circ} 06'$  E., 1.58 chs. dist., a granite stone, 15 x 13 x 9 ins., lying loose on the ground, mkd. with 2 grooves on E. and 2 grooves on S. sides, from which the original bearing trees mkd. by Hathorn:

A rotted fir stump and snag, 36 ins. diam., bears N.  $74^{\circ}$  E., 25 lks. dist., mkd. T, and other illegible scribing on pitched-over blaze. (Mensch record dist., 27 lks.)

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S.  $12\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 28 lks. dist., mkd. with illegible scribing on a partially opened blaze. (Mensch record bearing and distance, S.  $10^{\circ}$  E., 28 lks.)

A fallen fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S.  $45^{\circ}$  W.,
