

## County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Dependent Resurvey, Subdivisional Lines, T. 22 S., R. 4 W.

CHAINS  
39.93

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 17 and 20, reestablished and recorded by Weyerhaeuser Timber Co., at single proportionate distance, monumented with an aluminum pipe, 1 in. diam., firmly set, protruding 6 ins. above ground, from which:

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.  $49\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 27 lks. dist., mkd. with a plate and nail with W stamped on head. I mark this same tree  $\frac{1}{4}$  S20 BT.

A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S.  $66\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 55 lks. dist., mkd. with a plate and nail with W stamped on head.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which a new bearing tree:

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N.  $63\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 102 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S17 BT.

Reset aluminum pipe alongside iron post.

S.  $89^{\circ} 48'$  W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 165 ft. over NW. slope.

- 5.35 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. and S.
- 6.25 Old rail fence, bears N. and S.
- 6.55 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N.  $50^{\circ}$  W. and S.  $50^{\circ}$  E.
- 16.05 Woven wire fence, bears NW. and SE.
- 19.92 Woven wire fence, bears N. and S.
- 19.96 From this point an aluminum pipe, 1 in. diam., firmly set, protruding 6 ins. above ground, established and recorded by Weyerhaeuser Timber Co., bears North, .027 chs. dist.
- 23.05 Enter field, edge bears N. and S.  $10^{\circ}$  W.
- 39.70 Dirt road, 25 lks. wide, bears N.  $65^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $65^{\circ}$  W.
- 39.85 The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky clay.  
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, oak, madrone, and alder;  
undergrowth, hazel, arrowwood, huckleberry, salal,  
Oregon grape, vine maple, ferns, and vines.
