

Dependent Resurvey, Subdivisional Lines, T. 22 S., R. 6 W.

The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, perpetuated with an iron bolt,  $1\frac{3}{4}$  ins. diam., protruding 3 ins. above the ground, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

- A stump hole, bears N. 53° E., 42 lks. dist.
- A sawed fir stump, 44 ins. diam., bears S. 31° E., 114 lks. dist., mkd. locally, bark scribed S27 T22S R6W BT 239. (Record bearing, S. 40° E.)
- A sawed fir stump, 44 ins. diam., bears S. 53° W., 62 lks. dist., no marks remaining. (Record bearing, S. 56° W.)
- A stump hole, bears N. 75° W., 42 lks. dist.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

from which new bearing trees

- A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 6° E., 184 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R6W S22 BT.
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 38½° W., 92 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R6W S28 BT.
- A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 71° W., 159 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R6W S21 BT.
- No suitable bearing tree available in sec. 27.
- Reset iron bolt alongside iron post.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky clay.  
Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, dogwood, ash, alder, yew, maple, madrone, and chinquapin; undergrowth, young timber, hazel, arrowwood, salal, manzanita, huckleberry, poison oak, Oregon grape, vine maple, vines and ferns.

N. 0° 06' E., bet. secs. 21 and 22.

Ascend 115 ft. over SE. slope, across old logged area through moderate undergrowth.

- 2.10 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 75° E. and S. 75° W.
- 4.40 Allen Ridge, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E.; enter timber edge bears N. 15° E. and W.; desc. 490 ft. over NE. slope.
- 17.30 Draw, drains N. 70° E.; asc. 195 ft. over SE. slope.
- 32.10 Spur ridge, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.; desc. 145 ft. over broken NW. slope.
- 39.09 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 22, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
